*Interviewer: What do you like about 1st Chance?*

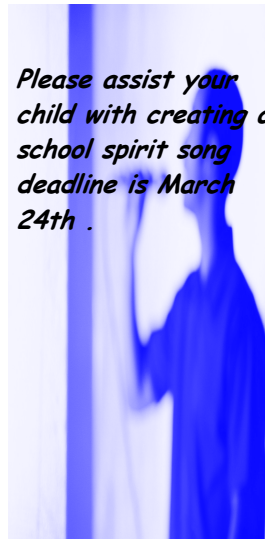
